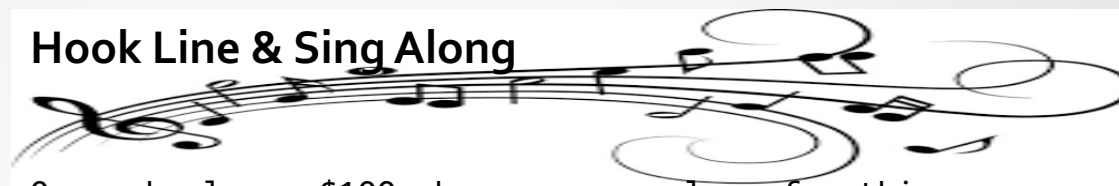

Hook Line & Sing Along

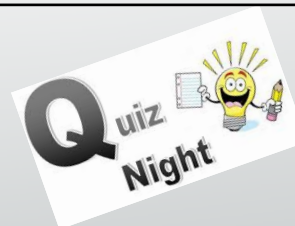


Our school won \$100 when we sang along for this competition. The video will be uploaded onto our school website soon, so keep an eye out for it.
